

Certificate Course in Kannada 2019- Onwards

(The class will be conducted beyond office hours to enable. The employees to attend the classes).

Duration :

The Postgraduate certificate course in Kannada is of one academic year's duration. After the completion of that year the successful students will be given a certificate. In case a batch of foreign students (from outside India) desire that the course should be condensed for 3 or 6 months, the adjustment may be made with due charges in the teaching hours.

Eligibility :

Candidates seeking admission to the above course must have passed the undergraduate degree (or an equivalent examination) examination of a recognised University.

Curriculum:

The course consist of two parts.

- A) Teaching programme B) Examination programme.
