

Dr. J. M. Chandunavar is presently the Professor and Chairman of the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism, Karnatak University, Dharwad. Before joining Karnatak University, Dr Chandunavar worked as Assistant Professor in the Department of Journalism and Mass Communication, Akkamahadevi Women's University, Vijaypur and Pandith Panchakshari Gavayi Arts College, Gadag. He has 29 years of teaching experience.

He was awarded a PhD for his thesis "Moharaj Hanumanthrao as Journalist: A study" by Karnatak University Dharwad (2001). This study focused on the contribution of Sumyukta Karnataka daily during the freedom movement, Karnataka unification, Hyderabad and Goa liberations and Mysore Andolana.

He has successfully guided five students for their doctoral degrees and is presently guiding five students for their PhD degrees. He is an expert in print and electronic media. He started his career as sub-editor at *Vishal Karnataka*, Hubli. He had also worked as Stringer/District in-charge for *Prajavani* and *Deccan Herald* in Gadag for three years. He has also worked in *Doordarshan* Bangalore as a Stringer for three years. He attended to more than 300 News Assignments, 50 *Krishi Dharshan* Programme (Agriculture development programmes for *Doordarshan*). He served as a Stringer for AIR News Unit, Dharwad for two years.

Dr. Chandunavar received an award from Karnataka Media Academy, Bangalore, for "The Best News feature with social concern in the 2007" which was broadcasted on *Chandana* channel. He served as a chief organizer for the first *Chandana Ustava* held at Dharwad.

He is the Editor of *Vidya Samchar*, a practice journal brought out by students of the Department of Journalism and Mass Communication, Karnatak University, Dharwad. Further, he has published three books and completed one UGC minor research project. He has to his credit 30 research papers published in reputed International/National Journals. He has presented research papers in 35 National and International Seminars. He has worked as a coordinator at the Department of M.Sc Electronic Media KUD and *Unnath Bharat Abhiyan* cell.

He has worked as NAAC, NSS Coordinator (Gadag) and as Coordinator, Career Guidance and Counselling Cell, AWU Vijayapur. He was also the Joint Coordinator of the National Seminar on 'New Frames and Perspectives' held in

April 2015, and Convenor of the National Seminar on 'New Media and Development' held in April 2016, Department of Mass Communication and Journalism, KUD
