
Report on Online Workshop on 'Academic Writing in Social Sciences and Humanities'

Workshop on **Academic Writing in Social Sciences and Humanities** in collaboration with Centre for Multidisciplinary Development Research, Dharwad on 7 December, 2020 for research scholars and teachers of the University and Colleges teaching social sciences and humanities.

Dr. Ajit Kumar Mishra, Associate Professor, Dept. of Humanistic Studies, IIT, Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh was the resource person. 304 participants attended the Workshop.
