The following Statute and Ordinance are presented to
the Chancellor on 22nd Sept. 1980. The copy of the
Ordinance is received through the State Government
under Letter No. ED 104 UKV 76 dated 14th Oct. 1980 from
the Secretary to Government, Education & Youth Services
Department, Bangalore.

Statute

- "(1) Ten Scholarships of which four shall be reserved
for Schedule caste/s/obliged tribes students
each of the value of Rs. 150/- per term shall be
instituted for the students joining Diploma Courses
in Gandhian Studies subject to the conditions laid
down in the guidelines framed for the purpose.
(2) The scholarships shall be awarded out of the
University Fund.
(3) An amount of Rs. 3,000/- be reserved in the
Budget each year for the purpose".

Ordinance

- (1) The Scholarships shall be awarded to the students
at the end of each term.
(2) These scholarships shall be on merit basis on the
term test.
(3) To qualify for the scholarship the candidate must
have kept 75% attendance at the lectures and
rural service work and obtained a minimum of 50%
of marks at the test.

9. If the Fellowship holder fails to appear for the M.Ed. (Regular) Examination or does not pass at the Examination, he/she shall not be paid for the last three months of the academic year.
10. Teaching Assistantship may be cancelled or deductions from the amount of Teaching Assistantship due, may be made by the Vice-Chancellor for misbehaviour, unsatisfactory progress or irregular attendance.
11. The Teaching Assistantship will be awarded for one year in the 1st instance and may be renewed next year if his progress in his studies is satisfactory and he passes the L.L.M. (Previous) Examination.

RULES GOVERNING THE AWARD OF UNIVERSITY FELLOWSHIPS FOR M.ED. COURSE

1. A candidate to be eligible for the University Fellowship should have obtained at least 55% marks at the B.Ed. Examination.
2. University Fellowship shall be confined only to those who exclusively pursue the M.Ed. regular course and shall not be actually working in their Teaching posts during the period of the course.
3. In case, there is a tie between two candidates securing an equal number of marks in the aggregate at the B.Ed. Degree examination one securing higher number of marks at the B.A. or B.Sc. and B.Com. degree examination shall be held eligible for the award.
4. If there is no eligible student of the Karnataka University, for being awarded the University Fellowship, the ceases of the other University Students, if there are any, may be considered for the award, only on recommendation of the Head of the Department of Education.
5. University Fellowship holder shall have to take part in the teaching or research work or any other academic assignment, if so required by the Head of the Department of Education. If he/she stays in the Hostel, shall have to assist the Hostel Superintendent in the work of supervising the Hostel.
6. The University Fellowship will commence from the actual date of admission and stipends shall be drawn quarterly (in arrears) in a bill signed by the student concerned and such a bill shall be accompanied by the report of the Head of the Department of Education regarding the satisfactory progress regular attendance and good conduct of the student concerned.
7. If the Fellowship holder discontinued the course in the middle of the year for no valid reasons and without the prior permission of the University he/she shall have to refund the amount drawn till then.
8. University Fellowship may be cancelled or deductions from the Fellowship amount due, may be made of the Vice-Chancellor, for misbehaviour, unsatisfactory progress or irregular attendance.

7. The candidate shall not accept or hold any appointment paid or otherwise, or receive any emoluments, salary, stipend etc., from any other source during the tenure of the award.
8. If it should appear at any time to the University that the progress or conduct of the scholar has not been satisfactory, his University studentship may be suspended or withdrawn on the recommendation of the Head of the Department.
9. If a student who holds a studentship fails to appear for the previous Examination or does not pass the previous University Examination, at the end of the First Year he shall not be paid the studentship for the last three months of the year.
Such vacant University Studentships shall be awarded on the basis of the marks obtained at the M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. previous Examinations as the case may be.
If a student who holds a studentship fails to appear for the final Examination or does not pass the Final University Examination at the end of the Final year he shall not be paid the Studentship for the last three months of the Final year also.
10. The studentship will commence from the date of commencement of academic year and the amount due to the holder, will be drawn quarterly, on a bill signed by the student concerned and countersigned by the Head of the Department in which the student is studying such a bill shall have the usual report from the Head of the Department regarding the Progress attendance and conduct of the student concerned.
11. The decision of the University shall be final in all matters concerning the awards.

RULES GOVERNING THE AWARD OF UNIVERSITY STUDENTSHIP

1. A candidate for being eligible for a studentship shall have obtained at least 50% of marks in the aggregate of the equal subjects at the B.A. Part-I, B.A. II and III, B.Sc. Part I, II and III taken together.
2. A candidate for being eligible for a studentship in the Department of Commerce, shall have obtained at least 50% of marks in the aggregate of all the subjects except English at the B.Com. Part-II and B.Com. Part-III, taken together.
The Studentship shall be awarded on the basis of merit. The total marks of the candidate at B.A. Part I, II and III and B.Sc. Part I, II and III in the equal subjects taken together should be the criterian for the award.
3. In case, there is a tie between two candidates who secures an equal total number of marks at the B.A. Part I, II and III and B.Sc. I, II and III examinations, the aggregate number of marks in equal subjects at the B.A. Part I, II and III and B.Sc. Part I, II and III shall be taken into consideration.
In case, there is a tie between two candidates who secures equal total number of marks at the B.Com Part II and B.Com. Part III Examination, the aggregate number of marks of all subjects including English at the B.Com. Part II and B.Com. Part III examination shall be taken in to consideration.
4. Preference shall be given to the students passing the Examinations from the Karnataka University in the year in which the studentship are awarded.
5. Preference shall be given to the students offering the same major subject at the degree examinations for which the studentship for Master's Degree course is instituted.
6. A candidate who is already a recipient of Government Fellowship or any Daxina Fellowship or any other Fellowships or any Financial assistance of a higher value shall not be awarded any University Studentship.
