**CIRCULAR**

**Sub: Admission to the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy for the Academic year 2021-22.**

**Ref : 1. Proceedings of Deans' Committee Meeting Dt : 16.03.2022  
2. Orders of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Dt : 11.04.2022**

By the direction of the Vice-Chancellor, it is hereby brought to the notice of all the Chairpersons of P.G Departments/Co-ordinators/Directors, K.U.Dharwad/Administrators of the PG Centers at Karwar, Gadag and Haveri that the following guidelines are to be followed in the Ph.D. Admissions for the Academic year 2021-22.

The allotment of Ph.D seats shall be as under :

- 1) The allocation of seats under the Exempted, Entrance and Differently-abled categories shall commence from the last roster point closed in the previous year.
- 2) Reservation for Differently-abled candidates is 5% . To be given only when the fraction is more than 0.50. The selection to the Differently-abled Category shall be taken up as per 100 point roster chart separately after filling the seats in open pool (GM and Reserved Categories).
- 3) Then the remaining seats are to be divided equally for the Exempted candidates and the candidates who are eligible from Entrance Examination.

**4) Hypothetical Examples,**

If the cutoff point for Ph.D admission for the previous academic year (Last number in 100 point roster system- seat allotted) is as following

PH - 1<sup>st</sup> SC.

Exempted Category- 10<sup>th</sup> (GM)

Entrance Category- 11<sup>th</sup> (IIB)

**a) An example for the even number of seats announced**

**d) An example for the odd number of seats announced**

If the total qualified candidates are 11 (Exempted + Qualified in Entrance) then the calculation is to be done as follows:

The remaining 10 seats are to be distributed as follows:

- 5) While allotting the seats, among the Exempted students, *the Percentage of Post-Graduation is to be considered only* irrespective of whether the candidate has qualified for JRF/GATE/NET/SLET/M.Phil with entrance test/ Government sponsored candidates. Whereas, foreign Govt. sponsored candidates' quota is over and above.
- 6) Research field/s along with the number of vacancies of a Research Supervisor is to be notified on the Department Notice Board and KUD website on the next day of the announcement of entrance examination results.
- 7) On the day of the interview the students are to be briefed about the guidelines (1-6) of the allotment of seats by the respective Chairperson of the Department. Also, the Research Field/s, vacancies are to be displayed on the notice board as shown below.

- 8) On the day of the interview, the duly filled in Proforma (To be provided by the Dept) of preference of Research Supervisors and the fields of research are to be collected from the candidates including the foreign candidates. A sample is given in the Annexure I.
- 9) If the area of research field and /or Research Supervisor opted by the candidate is not available during the allotment, the candidate may be allowed to choose the available specialization and research supervisor or to withdraw his/her candidature. To this effect, an undertaking shall be taken from the candidate.
- 10) The Department shall keep a record of the last roster-points used in Exempted, Entrance and Differently abled categories after all the allotments as above so as to continue from the previous roster points in the subsequent years. A copy of the same is to be sent to Dy. Registrar, Academic Section, K.U.Dharwad.
- 11) Vacant seats in any category/categories shall be filled to other categories applying 100 point roster chart within Differently abled/ Exempted/ Entrance category appeared students. Vacant/excess seats of exempted students shall be allotted to the Entrance test appeared students and vice versa applying 100 point roster system (As per Ph.D. regulation 29.5).
