- ii. Financial crunch – fees collected a very small proportion of total expenses, hence dependent on government, that is the lacuna in the Governmental and Non Governmental financial support.
- iii. Long duration vacancies of faculty positions leading to high student-teacher ratio and dependence on ‘guest’ faculty who may not be accountable
- iv. Hardly few facilities like data and internal audit. for monitoring the progress of the stakeholders

Action Taken:

A strategic plan has been prepared to harness the strengths and overcome the weaknesses. The focus is on navigating towards adoption of the provisions of the NEP

b. Short term and long term perspective plans administrative measures taken, Training to the non-teaching staff.

Human Resource Development Centre, Karnatak University, Dharwad functions according to the directives of the UGC, New Delhi with a pre approval schedule of programmes. Accordingly, we conduct the workshops, seminars, symposia and training courses to update their academic skills and art of working culture.

Since there is a programme to train the non-teaching staff programme, the same will be taken up as per the enclosed tentative programmes.

C. Administrative and academic reforms ushered in based on NAAC Peer Team recommendations and Administrative and Academic Audit (AAA) Committee reports (copies of recommendations/reports may be annexed).**1. Vacancy of teaching staff:**

- i. There is an urgent need to review the faculty positions in Departments.
- ii. Teachers from Govt. and aided and junior colleges with good experience, qualified in specialized areas are available, whose services could be utilized on deputation.
- iii. Deputation and provision of sabbatical leave in specialized areas from neighbouring states and abroad as a special case can also be used.
- iv. Refresher courses, capacity building workshops to teachers is recommended.

Other Vacancies:

Besides teaching faculty, vacancies of laboratory support in terms of Laboratory Assistants, and clerical staff to administrative offices, hostels, related support sections, estate office, need immediate look for management and administration.

2. Curriculum/Syllabus/BOS:

There is need to revisit the post-graduate syllabus in terms of employability, skill development and basic research involving interdisciplinary, multi-disciplinary area's incorporating emerging areas of IT, Biotechnology, Nano-Technology, Basic Studies in Physics, Electronics and Life Sciences. Similarly in Social Sciences and Languages may be followed. BOS could be reconstituted for effective restructuring of syllabus.

3. Collaboration with local Universities:

Collaboration with University of Agricultural Sciences, Dharwad: In the fields/areas of Biotechnology, Microbiology, Vermiculture, Women's Studies can be established. Research in social sciences with Agriculture Economics Marketing, post harvest storage and processing are additional areas of collaboration. 'Krishimela' is greater attraction to students to get exposure to learn agricultural development.

Similarly, association with Law University, IIT- Dharwad, KIMS-Hubballi, JNMC-Belagavi are additional avenues for collaboration.

4. **Strengthening University P.G. Centres at Haveri, Gadag and Karwar is required in terms of faculty and infrastructure.** At least an associate professor be made head of the Campus and designation may suitably be modified.

5. Students across the departments very strongly demanded rest rooms and toilets and drinking water facility. The committee feels of constraints of girl students whose strength is also high in the University.

6. **Hostels:** A couple of hostels need to be repaired. Fans, drinking water need particular attention. One more new girls hostel is recommended.

7. **Museums:** There are couple of museums viz, Botany, Zoology and History etc. New buildings are also made available. The resources to modernize museums should be explored through governments funding.

8. It was found in few departments that the **equipments are not put to use and also not repaired.** Special assistance to keep the equipment repaired be given.

9. Teachers and Research students from related departments may join together to **conduct monthly seminars,** conferences at state, national and international level.

10. Research scholars may be provided with fellowships, assistantship for their financial supports. Students need to be encouraged by senior faculty to apply for fellowships.

11. **Publications:** Good number of journals and periodicals are brought out by the University. Attempts may be made to improve ratings of the publications to attract research paper contribution from University faculty and outside. Editorial body with external experts may be required to improve quality and standards.

12. **Space Problems:** With increasing students intake in the University for PG Programmes, the department including established departments are facing space problems, conducive ambient atmosphere (toilets/ drinking water)

for effective learning situation. Long-terms and short-terms immediate requirements may be planned to solve the problems.

13. **Alumni Association:** Opportunities could be explored for financial assistance, employments, teaching assistance and many more activities at departmental level and university level.

14. **Energy Park:** The committee also recommends the university on starting **Energy Park** with emphasis on renewable energy resources like solar, wind, organic, wastes gasifiers biogas etc. Recycling of biodegradable wastes as biogas and manure for plants has tremendous possibilities. Funding from departments and renewable energy be explored.

Proper roof top harvest is a wonderful possibility of water shortage crisis. Recycling of hostel and residential waste water for gardening is a possibility. Planting of energy trees/fast growing plantations not only save soil run off but also provide water by giving for small tanks. Thereby providing build-up of ground water, favourable ecosystem and combat the rising environmental hazards.

15. **FM Radio and AIR:** University may have its own FM Station. All India Radio may be approached to allot a slot for 15 minutes to highlight the opportunities and achievements of university.

16. Accreditation of the affiliated college is also very necessary for quality education. The private colleges may be assisted and encouraged to get their institutions accreditation.

17. **Technologies:** Technologies developed through research may be popularized. Publication and communication to the end users be made. Wherever possible, worthy technologies be patented.

18. Dharwad is well known for music. Many music activities in public are held in the twin cities. Active participation of students and faculty must be able to use it. In house performance at departmental level is required.

19. Department of Foreign Languages needs total rehaul in terms of faculty, students, infrastructure and committee recommends introducing of couple more foreign languages.

20. Premises be kept clean. Campus requires beautification. Roads are to be repaired.

21. It has only 20% of institutions are NAAC accredited. The CDC need to reach college and train and encourage them to apply for accreditation.

22. There are certain departments which are eligible to get grant from various organizational programme like DST- FIST, UGC- SAP, have not applied for. Such department may be mentored to do so.

Action Taken:

The recommendations are conveyed to respective departments/sections and concerned university authorities for initiating suitable actions on the recommendations made by the AAA.

3. 1. Indira Gandhi P.G. Scholarship for Single Girl Child sponsored by the U.G.C., for the Girl Child pursuing degree at an amount of Rs.31,000/- p.a. for Two years (for 10 months). At present there are 08 students receiving this scholarship.

2. P.G. Merit Scholarship for Rank Holders by the U.G.C. at an amount of Rs.20,000/- p.a. tenable for one year (for 10 months). At present there are no such candidates receiving this scholarship.

4. PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED SCHOLARSHIP:-

This Scholarship is awarded from the Department of Women's and Children Welfare. Government of Karnataka @ Rs.6,000/- p.a. tenable for two years. (10 months in a year) subject to renewal. At present there are no students who are receiving this scholarship.

5. UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP:- This is from out of University Budget being provided for P.G. (Previous) students. The Scholarships are being awarded at the rate of Rs.500/- p.m. (for 10 months) to each Department i.e. at the students ratio of 20:1 based on the intake of each respective department. This award is tenable for two years. At present during 2020-21 year 113 students have been awarded this scholarship.

- 6. UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP:-** This is from out of University Budget being provided for M.Ed. course students. The Scholarships are being awarded at the rate of Rs.500/- p.m. (for 10 months) for 02 students. This award is tenable for two years. At present there are 02 students who are receiving this scholarship.
- 7. GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP:-** This is also out of the University Fund for P.G. (Pre) students. Two Fellowships for Science Faculty and two for Arts and Other Faculties. The award carries of Rs.60/- p.m. (for 10 months in a year) per student. At present there are 02 students who are receiving this scholarship. During, 2020-21 02 Students from Science faculty and 02 Students from other faculties have been awarded this scholarship.
- 8. GANDHIAN STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP:-** This is awarded to the students studying P.G. Diploma in Gandhian Studies. Total 10 Scholarships are made available. Assistive devices for differently abled users:** Karnatak University library has extended its services for differently abled users by facilitating the assistive devices where the users can reach the information by the audio facility. This service is provided near the entrance to encourage the differently abled users to use such services.
 - 6. 24x7 reading hall:** In order to facilitate the use of library resources without time restriction, library has established 24X7 open Reading Hall with all basic amenities. Students can sit and read at their convenience at any time.
 - 7. Similarity Index Check for Research Scholars:** All the Ph.D theses submitted to Karnatak University Dharwad, are checked for plagiarism (similarity index check) by using **URKUND** (original) an anti-plagiarism software provided by the INFLIBNET at the University library. During 2020-21, **124** reports of similarity index check (SIC) for Ph.D theses have been generated and provided to the researchers. From the year 2020-21 library has also started issuing SIC report for research articles too, **44** SIC reports have been generated for research articles till March 2021.
 - 8. Photo Copy Service:** This service is provided under fair use policy of copy right act in the library premises; the photo copying center is near the entrance hall which is easily accessible by all the users. Average number of pages photocopied per day is around 1600 pages.
 - 9. Bibliographical information service:** The University library provides bibliographical Information Services in selected areas by using databases available through INFLIBNET e-SHODHSINDU sources subscribed by the library and also through the existing print collection
 - 10. Green library:** In order to encourage the reading habits and to promote the interactive mode of studies in the natural environment, Library has established **04** pergolas in the premises of library lawn. This is the unique and special feature of the KUD library, where researchers are free to interact among themselves. They can also use their laptops and browse the information sources through the Wi-Fi facility.
 - 11. Library online public access catalogue (OPAC):** OPAC is readily available on Library Computers. Users can search his/her required document through the Author, Title, Subject Publisher and Keywords. This is also available through Campus Network
- i. Other Activities :**
- 1. Repair and Paint work:** To maintain the ambience of the library entrance hall and Librarian's Chamber have been painted and waterproofing work has also been done.
 - 2. Health Checkup medical camp** has been conducted in the premises of the library for University students on 16th April 2021, by Family Planning Association of India, Dharwad Branch; in collaboration with Youth Friendly SRH Counselling Centre Department of Social Work, Karnatak University, Dharwad.

35. PHYSICAL INFRASTRUCTURE**a. Constitution of works committee and resolutions of meetings held**

The Building Division is bounded by the decisions of the Estate Board also called as Building Works Committee. The Estate Board consists of 12 members, Chairman being the Vice-Chancellor (Ex-officio), Resident Engineer as Member Secretary (Ex-officio), One Superintending Engineer from KPWD (Ex-officio), Executive Engineer from HESCOM (Ex-officio), Three Members of Syndicate, one member of Academic Council. The Registrar (Ex-officio), Finance Officer (Ex-officio), Commissioner of HDMC (Ex-officio) & Dy. Director of Land Records (Ex-officio) cum TA to Dy. Commissioner as members.

The Powers & Functions of the Estate Board- is mainly In-charge of the University Estate and recommends to the Syndicate all new constructions, any additions or alterations or repairs to existing buildings, which may deem urgent or necessary. Also the Board is a Adviser to the Syndicate in all matters relating to the University Estates. The Board should have a minimum of four meetings in a year, before the Annual Convocation & at other times, when convened by the Vice-Chancellor. Four members of the Board shall form the quorum of any meeting. The Estate Board is reconstituted, in accordance with the proviso of respective. Ordinance & the tenure of the members of the Board (other than Ex-officio) is, for a period Two Years from the date of notification.

49. Vice-Chancellor's Views

Karnatak University, Dharwad was established in the year 1949. It is the second oldest university after Mysore. The architect of Karnatak University is Dr. D. C. Pavate who served as its Vice-chancellor from 1954 to 1967. The magnificent building aptly called 'Vidya Soudha' stands as testimony to his work. Covering an area of over 888 acres, the campus is now known as Pavatenagar. The university has its jurisdiction in Gadag, Haveri, and Uttar Kannada districts. Students are offered courses in Arts, Commerce, Education, Law, Management, Science & Technology and social Sciences. The university is considered as one of the top ranking universities in India. It has been identified as a 'University with potential for excellence and graded by NAAC with a five star status. It has 49 departments, 3 P.G. Centres, 5 Constituent Colleges, 277 affiliated Colleges, 156 P.G. Teachers, 2998 UG teachers, 3879 P.G students and to, 95279 UG students. The University has undertaken a number of maiden collaborative research initiatives with institutions both in India and abroad. Karnatak University is a vibrant combination of scientific, social, linguistic and cultural achievers the fragrance of which has spread across the country in the form of Bhatnagar awardees, Jnanpith awardees, poet laureates, musicians and social scientists. The university has contributed immensely to the social fabric of the country providing skilled manpower to all government and non-governmental sectors for the last six decades. The university has made its presence felt in USA, UK, Canada, Taiwan and Korea through its large number of students over the last sixty years. It has adopted several educational reforms and is now catching up with new ICT methods related to e-governance. Karnatak University has several memoranda of understanding (MOU) with state, national and international Government agencies, departments research institutes related to consultancy, training, exchange programmes, employment, Industrial training etc.

The university has been collaborating with the Academy of sciences centre for multi disciplinary research BLDE university vijayapura, Electronics sector skills council of India, New Delhi, Zilla panchayat, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Research Institute, Bureau of Pharma Public sector undertakings of India, Dept. of pharmaceuticals, Ministry of chemicals and fertilizer and Sydney sussex college, Cambridge. The University has instituted the Pavate travel Bursary which enables a scholar from Cambridge to spend two months at Karnatak University. The University has signed an agreement with the polytechnic Institute of Leiria in Portugal and the university of Londrina Brazil for research projects. The university has adopted the village of Mansur which is six Kms. from the university for community development under the 'campus to community programme. Under the ambit of this scheme, the university conducts Health camps in association with the Red cross society and musician's Day. The university is involved in Rain water conservation, Renovation of Tanks Distribution of seeds and seedlings and 'Free Education' of children.

It has been invited by MHRD, New Delhi to participate in the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Programme. A majority of the Indian workforce does not possess marketable skills which is an impediment in getting decent employment. However in the given system the educational entry requirements and long duration of

courses of the formal training system are some of the impediments for a person to acquire skills for his livelihood. The innovation, Incubation and Business centre has been established with the objective of linking companies, investors research innovation communities in the ever expanding technological development of the country.
