1.0 Title : Diploma in Marathi Modi Studies

2.0 Objectives :

- The Course is designed to teach *Modi* and Marathi with comparative perspective.
- In Karnataka, there are hardly two translators of *Modi* lipi having fluency over *Modi* Script. Making students to acquaint with this script is very essential. This course aims to create a lot of job opportunities in Judicial Department while addressing old land-house related disputes and cases. This *Modi* lipi is slowly disappearing and becoming extinct. Hence, the purpose of introducing this course is to retain that script and enabling the Marathi students to have job opportunities in Judicial sector.
- Another objective of the course is to provide comprehensive training (spoken and Written) in both *Modi* and Marathi Language. The course is going to infuse translation ability among the Marathi Students.

3.0 Commencements: These Regulations shall come into force from the academic year  
2023-24 onwards.

4.0 Definitions

In these Regulations, unless otherwise provided:

- A "Academic Council" means Academic Council of the University constituted according to the *Karnataka State Universities Act, 2000*.
- B "Board of Studies" means P.G./ U.G. Board of Studies in respective subjects of Karnatak University, Dharwad.
- C "University" means Karnatak University, Dharwad.
- D "Course" means subject or papers having specified units which go to comprise a specified programme of study.
- E "Credit" means the standard methodology of calculating teaching hours of the course per week in the semester system.
- i. 1 hour lecture or 1 hour tutorial per week is equal to 1 credit and that of 2 hours practical is equal to 1 credit. However, the concerned BOS shall decide the necessity for any Course.
  - ii. Courses with 3 to 4 credits shall be evaluated for 100 marks and courses with less than 3 credits, including practical, shall be evaluated for 50 marks.
- F "Candidate" means, a person seeking admission or appearing for examination to the

P.G. Diploma Course

- G **“Student”** means a person admitted to, and pursuing, a specified credit-based course/programme of study in a higher education institution.

## 5.0 Minimum Eligibility for Admission to Diplomas

A candidate, who has successfully completed Bachelor’s Degree programme **in respective subjects or as decided by the BOS** of this University or of any other University recognized as equivalent thereto by this University, shall be eligible for admission to the P.G. Diplomas provided the candidate also satisfies the conditions like the minimum percentage of marks and other eligibility conditions as prescribed by the University from time to time. Admission shall be as per the Govt. of Karnataka Reservation Policy and directions issued in this direction from time to time.

### 6.0 Diploma Programme: Duration, Eligibility and Intake :

- a. **Duration: Diploma in Marathi Modi Studies-1 year Duration** It is a 02 semesters Programme
- b. **Eligibility Criterion for admission to Diploma:** A candidate, who has successfully completed 02-years PUC or equivalent to PUC (10+2) **in respective course in the respective subject or as decided by the BOS** of this University, shall be eligible for admission to the Diplomas provided the candidate also satisfies the conditions like the minimum percentage of marks and other eligibility conditions as prescribed by the University from time to time. Admission shall be as per the Govt. of Karnataka Reservation Policy and directions issued in this direction from time to time.
- c. Total **Intake Limit:** 20 students.

**7.0 Teaching Course:** Each Course shall be taught for 4 hours per week during the period of 16 weeks in a given semester. However, the actual number of classes may not be 64 hours as per the above calculation. It may vary from Course to Course depending on the activities of the Department, general holidays and the calendar of events prescribed by the University from time to time.

8.0 Medium of Instruction: Marathi, English.

9.0 Scheme of Examination:

- \* There shall be a University Examination at the end of an academic year in theory.
- \* Candidates are allowed to write the examination in Marathi and Modi.
- \* The duration of theory paper examination shall be 02 hours.
