ABOUT KARNATAK UNIVERSITY

The Bombay legislature of the erstwhile Bombay Presidency established Karnatak University through the Karnatak University Act 1949. It became a statutory University on 1st March 1950. The University was recognized with the "Potential for Excellence" by the [University Grants Commission](#) and Accredited with NAAC "A" Grade. The University is the second oldest, after [University of Mysore](#). The jurisdiction of the University covers Dharwad, Gadag, Haveri and Uttar Kannada districts. It has several Post Graduate centres. The University (888 acres) is offering courses in the faculties of Arts, Commerce, Education, Law, Management, Science & Technology and Social Sciences. There are 51 PG Departments, 154 teachers and 4500 students (PG, PG Diploma., M.Phil and Ph.D.). The University has its own Primary and High School (University Public School) since 1964.

ABOUT BABU JAGJIVAN RAM CENTRE

Babu Jagjivan Ram : India is a country whose destiny is shaped by men of letter such as Dr.Babu Jagajivan Ram. Known popularly as Babuji, he was born to a poor dalit family in Bihar, but rose to the status of Deputy Prime Minister of the world's largest democracy by the dint of his hard work and innovative mind. Known for his courage dynamism, intelligence and oratory skills even during childhood days, Babuji was attracted by great leaders like Madan Mohan Malaviya and Mahatma Gandhi. Babuji occupied dozens of key positions in the Union Ministry viz., Labour, Transport, Communications, Employment, Rehabilitation, Food, Defence, Agriculture, Irrigation, Railways, etc. Babuji had the distinction of being the longest serving Member of Parliament and Minister in the history of Indian Parliament and was known for his brilliant handling of parliamentary affairs. Babuji as thus, one of the rarest gems of mother India, regarded as father of "Green Revolution".

Centre: With a view to carry out in depth study of his contribution and values, Government of Karnataka, Ministry of Social Welfare Department has sanctioned Dr. Babu Jagjivan Ram Studies, Research and Extension Centre in Karnataka University Dharwad in 2017 and was inaugurated by former Lokasabha Speaker and daughter of Babuji Smt.Mira Kumar, in 2018. The centre offers one year PG Diploma and Open Elective Courses since 2020, under the Faculty of Social Sciences.
