

Subject: Circular Regarding PhD Entrance Examination Results


Dear PhD Applicants,

With the above-cited subject, I wish to bring to your kind attention that we regret to inform you that, based on the results of the recent entrance examination, **none of the applicants have qualified in Entrance examination category** for admission to the PhD program this year. As per the guidelines set forth by the university, **General Merit (GM)** candidates are required to score a **minimum of 50 marks**, while candidates from Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), and Category-1 (CAT-1) backgrounds must attain a **minimum of 45** marks to be considered for admission. Upon careful evaluation of the examination results, it has been determined that none of the candidates have met the minimum required marks in accordance with the aforementioned criteria. Therefore, unfortunately, none of you have qualified for admission to the PhD program this academic year in the Entrance Test Category.
