1. The learners would have honed the skills acquired pertaining to Comprehension [oral & written] and Production [oral & written] of French language.
2. The skills acquired in the French language, along with phonetic specificities increases the learners' employability in the job market.
3. To train the learners in honing the acquired skills in French language pertain to (i) Oral Production- Comprehension & (ii) Written Production- Comprehension focusing on acquisition of French phonetic specificities among the learners at higher level: Level 2 of the language. It is for 250 marks (10 hours per week).
