"(iii) To meet expenditure on buildings or purchase of a house or a site.

(iv) To pay premium on policies of insurance on the life of the subscriber or wife.

(v) To pay for education outside India, whether for an academic, technical, professional or vocational course of the applicant or any person who is a member of the subscriber's family and actually dependent upon him.

(vi) To pay for medical engineering and technical or specialised courses in India, beyond the high school stage or the applicant or any person actually dependent on him provided that the course of study is not less than three years."

Further, part of the service rendered in undergraduate/Post-graduate College may also be taken into account for determining eight years of continuous service under this scheme.

b) Any teacher who has been considered and not selected for merit promotion in the initial presentation could, however, submit his work again only after a lapse of ONE YEAR."

The following amendment to the K.U. (Pension & Gratuity) Statutes-1981 is assented to by H.E. the Chancellor on 28-6-1985. The assent of the Chancellor is received through the State Government under their letters referred at 5 & 7 cited above.

Statute No. 2.3 :

These statutes are also applicable to the employees who have retired or died between 1-3-1950 and the promulgation of these statutes and whose retirement or family pension benefits have been settled or pending settlement under the contributory P.F. Scheme, provided that

i) An option in form No. 2 given by the retired official or the family of the deceased official as the case may be within one month after the issue of these Statutes in favour of the pension scheme;

ii) Such retired persons or family of the deceased official shall refund to the University share of the contributory provident fund along with the interest accrued thereon and the interest that would have accrued on the amount had it been continued in the contributory P. F. Accounts until the date of refund.

iii) Such retired persons or family of the deceased officials also refund the gratuity if any, paid to them with interest the rate applicable to contributory Provident Fund from the date of receipt of gratuity till the date of refund; and

iv) The monetary benefits after notional fixation of pension as on the date of retirement shall be given from 1-7-1976.

Statute No. 4.1 : "The date of compulsory retirement of an University employee is the date on which he attains the age of (i) 60 years, if he belongs to the teaching cadre and (ii) 58 years, if he belongs to the non-teaching cadre".

Note (1) : The compulsory retirement of an employee belonging to Non-teaching cadre retired prior to 1-7-1976 shall be 60 years which shall be computed for qualifying service for purpose of pension.

Note (2) : Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing proviso, all Government Orders, Notifications, official Memorandums, Circulars etc., are hereafter issued from the Government of Karnataka complimentary to, or in addition to KCSRs, with regard to the age of

retirement, shall be adopted "Mutatis Mutandis" to University employees (effective from 2nd August, 1984).

"Minimum qualifications for recruitment for the post of University Professor in Jainology in the Faculty of Arts shall be as prescribed by the consultative Committee as under:

Essential :

I) a) M.A. First or Second Class Degree of a recognised University with Jainology or Classifical Literature (Sanskrit and Prakrit, Kannada, Tamil, Hindi and Gujarati) or Philosophy or Indian History (preferably Ancient or Medieval) or Indian Culture.

b) and a Doctorate degree in a subject covering Jainism, its doctorines or its cultural aspects or its literature.

c) and research ability evidenced by original papers, publications, etc., connected with Jainology, subsequent to the Doctoral Degree.

II) teaching experience of Not less than ten years in a College or Post-graduate Departments in the University, on the subject of Jainology or cognate subject relevant to the main subject.

(Note By 'Cognate' is meant any discipline with a clear bearing on Jaina contribution.)

III) research experience either acquired or guidance to Ph.D. candidates.

Note : What is desired is Post-doctoral experience of not less than five years under either category).

"Teaching staff of the Constituent Colleges of the University shall be given benefit of Time-Bound Advancement on par with the Government order No.FD 88 SRP (CSCO 81 dated 27-3-82, as shown below:

1 Scope and date of effect:

1.1 A scheme of time-bound advancement for University servants is introduced with effect from 1st April, 1982, subject to the provisions of G.O. No. FD 88 SRP (CSC) 81 dated 27th March, 1982;

1.2 Under the scheme all posts in any scale of pay specified in column 2 of the table given below, shall carry selection time scale of pay indicated in the corresponding entry in column 3 abid:

1.3 The employee holding any post mentioned in para 1.2 either on an officiating basis or in a temporary or substantive capacity shall

be permitted to move on to the selection time scale of pay assigned thereto, subject to fulfilment of the conditions stipulated in para 2 of this Statute.

2. Conditions of eligibility :

2.1 Movement of a University teaching employee to the selection time scale of pay assigned to the post held by him shall be subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

a) The employee should have completed a service of 12 years in the post held by him, the period of service being computed in the same manner as service for the purpose of seniority is determined in accordance with the University rules as in force from time to time.

b) The employee should have a satisfactory record of service, the satisfactory nature of service being determined in the same manner as merit is determined for promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-merit.

c) Where there is avenue of promotion, the employee should be qualified and eligible for promotion in accordance with the C & R rules of the University.

2.2 The suitability of the University employee holding a post in any scale of pay mentioned at Sl. Nos. 8 to 11 in column 1 of the above table for movement to the selection time scale of pay assigned to the post held by him shall be subject to the screening by the board of appointment of the University as constituted under Section 49,50,51 of KSU Act, 1976, as the case may be OR in the absence of such a committee by the appointing authority as provided under the provisions of KSU Act, 1976.

2.3 The employee who has voluntarily foregone promotion shall not be eligible for movement to the -election time scale of pay.

2.4 The employee who has been once permitted under the scheme to move on to the selection time scale of pay shall be eligible for the benefits of selection time scale of pay during the remaining period of his/her service.

2.5 Subject to fulfilment of the above conditions;

a) University employee, has completed a service of 12 years in the post held by him as on 31st March, 1982, shall be permitted to

move on to the selection time scale of pay assigned to the post held by him with effect from 1st April, 1982, and

b) The employee who completes a service of 12 years in the post held by him on or after 1st April 1982, shall be permitted to move on to the selection time scale of pay assigned to the post held by him, with effect from the date following the date of completion of such service.

3. Authority competent to permit movement to selection time scale of pay.

Authority competent to permit the movement to selection time scale of pay, subject to the provisions of para 2.2 of this Statutes, the authority competent to permit the University teaching employee to move on to the selection time scale of pay assigned to the post held by him/her in accordance with the provisions of this Statute is the "Appointing Authority" as per provisions of the K.S.U. Act. 1976.

4. Fixation of pay

4.1 Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary contained in the Karnataka Civil Services Rules, the pay of the University servant who is permitted to move on to the selection time scale of pay shall be fixed in accordance with the provisions of Rule 42-B of the said Rules.

4.2 In the University employee who has been permitted to move on to the selection time scale of pay, is given promotion within two years from the date of his movement to the selection time scale of pay, his pay on promotion shall be fixed with reference to the pay which he would have drawn but for his movement to the selection time scale of pay.

5. Application

5.1 Subject to the provisions of para 5.2, these orders shall be applicable to all the University teaching employees whose service conditions are governed by the K. U. Service Rules as in force from time to time.

5.2 These orders shall not be applicable to :

- a) Persons employed on contract, except when the contract provides otherwise.

- b) Persons appointed as local candidates, and
- c) Persons appointed on consolidated pay or on part-time basis".

(I) "The University employees borne on regular establishments who are blind or Orthopaedically handicapped with the disability of lower extremities shall be granted a conveyance allowance of 5 percent of

basic pay subject to maximum of Rs. 40/-p.m. and revised by the Govt. from time to time and further subject to the following conditions :

i) The Conveyance allowance shall be allowed to Orthopaedically handicapped University employees if he or she has a minimum of 40 percent permanent partial disability of either upper or lower limbs or 50 percent permanent partial disability of both upper and lower limbs, either together. for the purpose of estimation of disability, the standards as contained in the manual of Orthopaedical surgeon in evaluation Permanent Physical Impairment through out by the American Academy of Orth. Surgeon, U.S.A. and published on this behalf by artificial limbs manufacturing Corporation of India, G.T. Road, Kanpur shall apply.

ii) The Conveyance allowance will be admissible to the Orthopaedically handicapped employees on the recommendation of the Head of the Orthopaedic Dept. of a Government Civil Hospital.

iii) In the case of Blind employees, the allowance will be admissible on the recommendation of the Head of Ophthalmological Dept. of Government Civil Hospital.

iv) The allowance will not be admissible during leave (except casual leave), joining time or Suspension.

II. In cases where handicapped University employees are referred by the Vice-Chancellor to Govt. Civil Hospitals located outside their headquarters for getting recommendations for grant of conveyance allowance, they may be reimbursed actual travel expenses subject to a maximum of T.A. admissible for journey without any daily allowances for the period of their journey and for halts. The period spent on journey as also at Hospitals shall however be treated as duty. The registrar of the University is authorised to sanction conveyance allowance in terms of these orders".

v) If there is provision for teaching of any subject of one of the subject grouped under a Board of Studies in any of the affiliated or constituent Colleges of the University at least one member of the Board of Studies shall be from among the teachers teaching the subject or any one of the subjects concerned.	

- vi) A teacher of the Post-graduate Department of Studies of the University or a teacher of the affiliated/ constituent Colleges shall cease to be a member if he ceases to be a teacher of the concerned category to which he belonged to at the time of his nomination to the Board of studies.
- vii) Any casual vacancy may be filled for the unexpired period.
- viii) The Vice-Chancellor shall nominate two additional members to each of the Board of Studies in the subject/ subjects from other Universities for a period of three years.
- ix) "Each Board of Studies by a resolution at a meeting co-opt two members working in the Karnatak University in the field as member (s) of the Board for a period which is co-terminal with the period of the Board."

Meetings:

- i) All Boards of Studies shall ordinarily meet at least once a year and on such occasions may be determined by the Vice- Chancellor.
- ii) Not less than fifty percent of the members in each Board of Studies shall constitute the quorum for a meeting.
- iii) In the absence of the Chairman at any of the meetings of the Board of Studies one of the members elected by the members present shall act as Chairman for that meeting.
- iv) All question before the Boards of Studies shall be decided by a majority of persons present and voting. In case of equality of votes on any issue, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.
- v) If in the opinion of the Vice-Chancellor, it is not necessary or expedient to convene a meeting of the Board of Studies to consider any item and if he considers that a matter could be disposed of by circulation among the members of the Board he may issue necessary instructions to that effect.

Joint Meetings:

- i) A joint meeting of two or more Boards of Studies may be convened if so directed by the Vice-Chancellor to consider matters as may be specified.

- ii) The Vice-Chancellor or a person designated by him shall preside over such meeting. The quorum for joint meeting shall not less than 50% of the total number of members of all Boards so convened.
- iii) The joint meeting shall consider question/s or matter/s referred to it and shall submit a report thereon.

Functions of Boards of Studies:

- i) To consider and recommend courses of Studies, text books, standards of passing and conduct of examinations preparation of panels of examiners and any their academic matter concerned or related to matters specified above.
- ii) To consider and report on all other matters as may be referred to it by any authority / Officer of the University.

STATUTES RELATING TO ELECTIONS TO THE AUTHORITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY

St. 1. : Definitions:

1. In this Chapter unless the context otherwise requires:

i) 'teachers' means teachers employed in a University Department, University College or an affiliated college.

ii) 'Registered Graduate' means a graduate as defined in Section 2 (5) of the Karnataka State Universities Act, 1976 and whose name has been registered as such in accordance with the provisions of these Statutes.

iii) 'Continuing candidate' means any candidate not elected and not excluded from the poll at any given time.

iv) 'Exhausted Paper' means ballot paper on which no further preference is recorded for a continuing candidate, provided that a paper shall also be deemed to have become exhausted whenever.

a) the names of two or more candidates whether continuing or not, are marked with the same figure and are next in order of preference; or

b) The name of the candidate next in order of preference whether consecutively after some other figure on the ballot paper or by two or more figures.

v) 'First Preference' means the figure 1 set opposite the name of a candidate; 'Second Preference' means the figure 2 set opposite the name of a candidate; 'Third Preference' means the figure 3 set opposite the name of a candidate and so on.

vi) 'Original Vote', in relation to a candidate means a vote derived from a ballot paper on which a first preference is recorded for such candidate.

vii) 'Surplus' means the number by which the votes of any candidate original and transferred, exceeds the quota,

viii) 'Transferred Votes' in relation to any candidate means votes credited to such candidate which are derived from a ballot paper on which a second or subsequent preference is recorded.

ix) 'Unexhausted Paper' means a ballot paper on which a further preference is recorded for a continuing candidate.

x) 'Act' means the Karnatak State Universities Act, 1976 as amended from time to time.

2. Words and expression used but not defined in these statutes shall have the meaning assigned to them in the Act.

St: 2 : Elections to be held in accordance with this Chapter :

All elections to the authorities shall be held in accordance with the provisions of this Chapter unless there is a provision to the contrary or unless it is inconsistent with or repugnant to the subject or context.

St: 3 : Registration of Graduates:

1. The Registrar shall cause a general notification to be issued at least six months prior to the date on which the elections to the Senate are to be held from the registered graduates constituency calling upon the

graduates residing within the university area to register their names in the Electoral rolls of the appropriate category of the registered graduates.

2. From the date of the above notification at least 45 days shall be given to enable the graduates to register themselves.

3. The application in the prescribed form (Form-I) shall be submitted in duplicate on or before the last date specified in the notification referred to above alongwith the documentary evidence of the applicant having obtained a degree in terms of Section 2 (5) of the Karnataka State Universities Act. and also a self declaration certificate of residence within the University area for a period not less than 2 years as on 31st January of the year in which the election is to be held in a prescribed proforma (Form-II)

4. Within 30 days of the last date notified for registration all valid applications for registration shall be classified according to the constituency and draft electoral rolls talukawise be prepared by the University. They shall be kept in the University Office for inspection for a period of at least 15 days for corrections if any on an application by the concerned graduate. After the lapse of this period the electoral rolls for the electoral year shall be finalised as herein after detailed and shall not be corrected or modified except as provided in Statute-6.

5. A. Registered graduate who holds more than one degree from different faculties and thereby is eligible to be included in more than one constituency shall indicate in his application the particular constituency shall indicate in his application the particular constituency (i.e. one of Law, Medicine, Engineering, Commerce, General Graduates) for which he wishes to have his name included for purposes of participating in the ensuing elections to the Senate.

The constituency mentioned in the application shall be final and no change in the constituency shall be permitted there after under any circumstances in so far as the ensuing elections to the Senate are concerned. If no constituency is mentioned his application be rejected.

6. Graduates who apply in the aforesaid manner for inclusion of their names in the electoral roll under the above provision shall be assigned to the appropriate constituency mentioned in their application.

7. Only the graduates who have registered are eligible to contest/ vote in the election from the constituency for which they have registered.

8. No registered graduate shall be entitled to contest as a candidate or vote in more than one of the constituency referred to in Section 21 (I) (20) of the Act.

9. Any omission or error in the electoral rolls shall not by itself vitiate an election.

St: 4: Maintenance of Electoral Rolls:

1. The Registrar shall maintain the electoral rolls of all the persons and bodies entitled to elect members to the authorities of the University showing the names and addresses, age, sex and degrees, of all persons and names of bodies qualified to vote. Separate electoral rolls shall be maintained in respect of each of the following constituencies:

- i) Constituency of Registered Graduates in Law (S. 21 (1) (20) (a);
- ii) Constituency of registered Graduates in Engineering (S.21 (I) (20) (b))
- iii) Constituency of Registered Graduates in Commerce (S. 21 (1) (20) (c);
- iv) Constituency of Registered Graduates in Medicine (S. 21) (1) (20) (d);
- v) Constituency of registered Graduates other than those specified in Clauses (i) to (iv) above. (S.21(1) (20) (e);
- vi) Combined constituency of all Registered Graduate for the election of one woman Registered Graduate (S.21 (1) (21);
- vii) Constituency of teachers other than Principals, Professors and Directors in Post-graduate Departments (S. 21 (1) (18) ;
- viii) Constituency of Professors and Directors in the Post-Graduate Department from each faculty (S. 21 (10) (19) and
- ix) Constituency of teachers who are not Deans of Faculties or Heads of Post-Graduate Departments of studies or Principals of Colleges (S. 26) (vii);)

2. All teachers shall be entitled to be registered in the electoral roll for the respective constituency. In order to enable the Registrar

to maintain the electoral rolls corrected up to-date the Principal of every College shall immediately inform the registrar about every change in the teachership of that college and the Registrar, shall on receipt of the information, strike off from the electoral roll the names of persons who have ceased to be and include there in the names of Persons who have become teachers of that college. The registrar shall *sou motu* register in the respective electoral rolls the names of the teachers who are employees of the University and make necessary changes as and when teachers are appointed by the University or cease to be such teachers.

St: 5: Elections to be held at meetings:

The following elections shall be held at the meetings of the respective bodies:

- i) Election of five members by the Karnatak Legislative Assembly to the Senate (S.21 (1) (14);
- ii) Election of two members by the Karnataka Legislative Council to the Senate (S.21 (1)(15);
- iii) Election of three persons by the Senate to the Syndicate (S.24 (vi);
- iv) Election of two members of the Academic Council elected by its members to the Syndicate (Section 24 (ix);
- v) Election of one member of the Senate to the Academic Council (S.26 (iii);
- vi) Election of one member of the Syndicate to the Finance Committee (S.30 (ii);
- vii) Election of one member of the Senate to the Finance Committee (S.30 (iii).

St. 6: Correction of Electoral Rolls:

The Vice-Chancellor shall have the authority to correct the electoral rolls if any omission or wrongful inclusion or need for deletion/ addition consequent on nomination or appointment is brought to his notice before the last date fixed for receipt of nominations. No corrections shall be made after that date.

St. 7: Copies of Electoral Rolls:

Copies of the electoral rolls shall be furnished on payment of such charges as may be specified by the Vice-Chancellor.

St. 8: Returning Officer:

The Registrar or such other officer as might be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor shall be the Returning Officer and as such responsible for the conduct of Elections:

St. 9: Powers of the Vice-Chancellor:

1. The Vice Chancellor shall have power:

- i) To fix the time limits for filling nominations and with drawal of nominations;
- ii) To fix the date of election;
- iii) To order the holding of elections in anticipation of vacancies about to occur by efflux of time.

2. If in the opinion of the Vice-Chancellor an emergency has arisen, it, shall be competent for him to assume the powers of the Returning Officer and function as such either by himself or by deputing any other person therefor when in any election, the Returning Officer cannot carry out his duties.

St. 10: Election Notifications:

1. In case of election of members to the Senate by the Karnataka Legislative Assembly and the Karnataka Legislative Council under Clauses (14) and (15) of Section 21 (1) of the Act, the Registrar shall send a communication to the Secretary, Karnataka Legislature, informing him that an election of the member or members of the Assembly or the Council or of both to the Senate be held and the result thereof communicated to the Registrar as soon as possible.

2. In case of the following elections, a notification shall be published in at least two or more approved news papers to be selected by the Vice-Chancellor, the publication being at least twenty-eight days before the date of election.

- i) Election of member to the Senate from the Registered Graduates Constituencies under Clauses (20) of Section 21 (1) of the Karnataka State Universities, Act, 1976
- ii) Election of five representatives of teachers to the Senate under Clause (18) of Section 21 (1) of the K.S.U. Act, 1976.
- iii) Election of one Professor or Director in the Post-Graduate Departments from each of the faculties to the Senate by the Professors and Directors in Post-Graduate Departments of that faculty under clause (19) of Section 21 (1) of the Act.
- iv) Election of one Women Registered graduate to the Senate under Clause 21 of Section 21 (1) of the K.S.U. Act, 1976 and
- v) Election of ten teachers (who are not Deans of faculties, Chairman, Departments of Studies or Principals of Colleges) to the Academic Council under Section 26(vii) of the K.S.U. Act, 1976.

3. The Notification shall give the following particulars:

- i) the constituency and the number of seats to be filled by election in each constituency;
- ii) The date fixed as the last date for receiving nominations, the date so fixed being not less than fourteen days before the date of election;
- iii) the date and time fixed for the scrutiny of nomination papers;
- iv) the date and time before which the nomination may be withdrawn;
- v) the date and time of election and the place/s of voting.

4. In case of an election to be held at a meeting of any authority or body, the notice of election shall be given to every members of the authority or body at least twenty one clear days before the date of election, fixing the last date and time for receipt of nominations not less than ten clear days before the date and time of the meeting for elections;

5. All elections to the authorities of the University shall be in accordance with the system of proportional representation by means of singal transferable vote.

St. 11: Nomination of the Candidates:

1. Nomination papers shall be in the form prescribed by the Vice-Chancellor and shall be dated and signed by two electors one of whom shall be the proposer and the other the seconder and shall contain the names in full, addresses and designations of the signatories and of the candidate nominated. No person shall be nominated as a candidate nominated. No person shall be nominated as a candidate for election until he signifies his consent on the nomination paper.

Notwithstanding anything contained above, where the number of voters in any constituency is less than three the nomination papers in the prescribed form shall be submitted by the candidate himself under his signature without being proposed and seconded.

2. The nomination paper should reach the Returning Officer before the date and time fixed for the purpose. Any nomination paper which is received after the date and time fixed or which is not accompanied by the deposit receipt referred to in St. 12, or which does not comply with any of the formalities required by the statutes shall be rejected.

St. 12: Deposit by Candidates:

1. Every candidates at an election on the Senate by any of constituencies of Registered Graduates shall deposit with the University a sum of Rs. 100/- and the receipt for payment of the amount of the deposit shall accompany his nomination paper, the candidate shall not deemed to be duly nominated unless the said deposit has been made.

2. The deposit referred to in clause (1) shall be forfeited to the University if the candidate is not elected and number of votes credited to him at the last count before he is excluded or before the last of the successful candidates is elected less than one -eighth of the quota.

3. The Deposit shall be refunded.

- i) if the nomination of the candidate is declared invalid or
- ii) if the candidate duly withdraws his candidature, or
- iii) if he dies before the date fixed for the scrutiny and counting votes, or
- iv) if he is elected or
- v) if the candidate is not elected and the deposit is not forfeited under clause (2).

St. 13: Scrutiny of Nominations:

1. As soon as possible after the last day fixed for receipt of nominations, at the time and place fixed and notified in the notice of elections, the Registrar or any person nominated by him shall scrutinise the nominations and decide their validity. The candidate or his agent duly authorised in writing shall be entitled to be present at such scrutiny.

2. A list of candidates whose nomination papers have been declared valid shall be published on the notice Board in the Officer of the University on the same day and copy of the same forwarded to each of the candidates nominated for election.

3. In case of dispute about the decision as to the validity, or otherwise of any nomination, the matter may be referred to the Vice-Chancellor or in his absence a Dean of the faculty as designated by Vice-Chancellor whose decision shall be final.

St. 14: Withdrawal of Candidature:

Any candidate may withdraw his candidature by a notice in writing and attested to by two voters in the form prescribed by the Vice-Chancellor and all such applications should reach the office of the Registrar before the time fixed on the date notified for the purpose.

Provided that where the number of voters in any constituency is less than three, a candidate may withdraw his candidature by a notice in writing in the prescribed form, without being attested.

St. 15: List of candidates to be notified:

The Returning Officer shall publish as soon as practicable on the Notice Board a final list of candidates validly nominated.

St. 16 : Preparation of the ballot paper:

1 The ballot paper for every election to any of the authorities of the University shall contain the names of all the candidates, whose nomination papers have been accepted, the names being arranged in the alphabetical order. If the two or more candidates bear the same name, they shall be distinguished by the addition of their occupation or residence or some other manner.

2. The ballot paper shall bear the authorised stamp of the University and shall not bear any serial number. The counterfoils of the ballot papers shall be serially numbered.

3. The ballot paper may contain particulars as mentioned in Form III (enclosed).

St. 17: Procedure of election at a Meeting:

1. The polling shall take place by secret ballot on the day of the meeting of the electing authority at the time fixed by the Vice-Chancellor for the purpose.

2. All members present at the meeting shall be entitled to vote. No vote shall be given by proxy. Members present shall sign in the nominal electoral roll kept for the purpose as a record of voting at the election.

3. The Returning Officer shall ascertain that the person desiring to vote is a member who has not already voted and shall enter his name upon the counterfoil of the ballot paper in the ballot paper book obtaining signature on the counterfoil and shall then tear out the ballot paper corresponding to that counterfoil and hand it to the member.

4. When a member has received a ballot paper, he shall proceed to the place arranged for marking the vote and shall record his vote by placing the figure in the space opposite the name of the candidate for whom he votes. The figure 1 shall be placed opposite the name of the candidate only; relative preference for the other candidates may be indicated by placing in the spaces opposite their names the figures 2, 3, 4 etc. in the order of such preference.

5. After the ballot papers are deposited in the ballot box kept for the purpose, the Returning Officer shall conduct the scrutiny with the help of scrutineers nominated by the Chairman of the meeting from among those present.

6. After the counting is over, the Returning Officer shall intimate to the Chairman the number of votes secured by each candidate and the Chairman shall declare the result. In case of equality of votes success shall be determined by lot.

St. 18: Election Procedure Generally:

Unless the subject or the context otherwise indicates the following rules shall be applicable to all elections of the University.

1. If the number of contesting candidates is more than the number of seats to be filled, a poll shall be taken.

2. If the number of such candidates is equal to the number of seats to be filled, the Returning Officer shall forthwith declare all such candidates duly elected.

3. If the number of such candidates is less than the number of seats to be filled, the Returning Officer shall forthwith declare all such candidates to be elected and take necessary action under Statute -10 to fill the remaining seat or seats.

4. Polling Centres shall be provided at suitable places within the University area and voters be assigned to each of such centres by the Vice-Chancellor.

5. A notice shall be put up at each polling centre, indicating;

- i) the name of the election;
- ii) the names of the contesting candidates and
- iii) the hours of voting.

6. An election officer, shall be appointed by the Returning Officer for each polling centre. The election Officer who will be in charge of the polling centre shall maintain order at the centre. No person other than a voter shall be permitted to enter the polling centre.

7. No voter shall be allowed to enter the polling centre for recording his vote, before the commencement or after the expiry of the period fixed for polling.

8. Every polling centre shall have such number of compartments as the election officer considers necessary to enable the voters to record their votes within the prescribed time limit.

9. Immediately before the commencement of the polling the election officer shall show to the candidate or his authorised agent present at the centre, that the ballot box is empty and then lock and seal it for use.

10. As each voter enters the polling centre, the election officer, shall check up the voter's name and other particulars and take all the reasonable care to ensure the identity of the voter before the issue of the ballot paper.

11. If a person, representing himself to be a particular voter applies for a ballot paper after another person has already voted as such voter he shall, on a satisfactorily answering such questions relating to his identity as the election officer may put, be issued a ballot paper. The ballot paper to be issued in such cases shall be serially the last in the bundle of ballot papers issued for use at the polling centre and words 'Tendered Ballot Paper' shall be endorsed on the back of it by the election officer. The

voter after marking the tendered ballot paper in the voting compartment shall not put in the ballot box but deliver it to the election officer who shall place it in a separate cover suitably marked.

Explanation: In the case of Registered Graduates " Reasonable care" would mean verification of signature of the voter against his signature in the Registration form made available to the election officer.

12. Before the ballot paper is issued to a voter the number of the voter as in the Electoral Roll shall be entered on the counterfoil and the counterfoil shall be signed by the voter. A mark shall be placed by the issuing officer in his copy of the electoral roll against the number if the voter to whom the voting paper is issued.

13. The Voter, on receiving the ballot paper, shall forthwith proceed to one of the compartments where he shall mark his Vote. He shall then put the ballot into the ballot box kept in front of the election officer.

14. Every voter shall vote without undue delay and shall leave the polling centre as he has put the ballot paper into the ballot box.

15. If a voter spoils his ballot paper inadvertently he may be given another paper and the spoiled paper and its counterfoil shall be cancelled by the election officer.

16. Each contesting candidates may appoint an agent at a polling centre who shall be duly authorised by him in writing, such agent shall present the instrument of authorisation to the election officer to enable the latter to permit him to be present at the polling centre.

Statute 19: Ballot Paper when invalid:

A ballot paper is invalid:

- i) If it does not bear the authorised stamp of the University; or
- ii) If there is any mark or writing by which the voter can be identified; or
- iii) if the figure (1) is not marked; or
- iv) if the figure (1) is set opposite the name of more than one candidate or is so placed as to render it doubtful to which candidate it is intended to apply; or

- v) If the figure (1) and some other figures are set opposite the name of the same candidate.

Explanation:

Ballot paper is also valid if the figure/s (I) etc. are expressed in numerals, Kannada/Roman or words in Kannada/English.

Statute 20: Scrutiny and counting of votes:

1. After rejecting the ballot papers which are invalid the Returning Officer shall.
 - i) Arrange the remaining ballot papers in parcels according to the first preference for each candidate.
 - ii) Count and record the number of papers in each parcels and the total number; and
 - iii) Credit to each candidate the value of the papers in this parcel.

2. The numbers of the papers in all parcels shall then be added together and the total divided by a number exceeding by one the number of vacancies to be filled and the result increased by one shall be the number sufficient to secure the return of a candidate herein after called 'the quota'.

i.e. =
$$\frac{(\text{Total number of valid votes})}{(\text{Number of candidate to be elected} + \text{One})} = \text{Result} + 1 = \text{Quota.}$$

3. If at any time a number of candidates equal to the number of persons to be elected has obtained the quota, such candidates shall be treated as elected and no further steps shall be taken.

4. Any candidate, in whose parcel the number of votes on the first preferences being counted is equal to or greater than the quota, shall be declared elected.

5. (a) If the number of the papers in any such parcel is equal to the quota, the papers shall be set aside as finally dealt with.

(b) If the number of the papers in any such parcel is greater than the quota, the surplus shall be transferred to the continuing candidates indicated on the ballot papers as next in the order of the voter's preference in the manner prescribed in Clause 6.

6. (a) If and whenever, as a result of any operation prescribed by these Statutes a candidate has a surplus that surplus shall be transferred in accordance with the provisions of this clause.

b) If, in ascertaining the number of papers to be transferred from a sub-parcel fractional parts are found to exist and if, owing to the existence of such fractional parts, the number of papers to be transferred is less than the surplus, as many of these fractional parts taken in the order of their magnitude, beginning with the largest as are necessary to make the total number of papers to be transferred equal to the surplus, shall be reckoned as the value of unity and the remaining fractional parts shall be ignored. If two or more fractional parts are of equal magnitude, that fractional part shall be deemed to be the larger which arises from the larger sub-parcel, and if the sub-parcels in question are equal in size, preference shall be given to the candidate who has obtained the larger number of original votes.

c) If more than one candidate has surplus, the largest surplus shall be dealt with first and the others in the order of the magnitude; provided that every surplus arising on the first count of votes shall be dealt with before these arising on the second count, and so on.

d) Where two or more surpluses are equal, the Registrar shall decide, as hereinafter provided in Clause (11) which shall be first dealt with.

e) i) If the surplus of any candidate to be transferred arises from original votes only all the papers in the parcel belonging to the candidate whose surplus is to be transferred shall be examined and the un-exhausted papers be divided into sub-parcels according to the next preferences recorded thereon. A separate sub-parcel shall be also be made of the exhausted papers.

ii) The number of the papers in each sub- parcel and the total of all un-exhausted papers shall then be ascertained.

iii) If the total number of the unexhausted papers is equal to or less than the surplus, all the sub-parcels shall be transferred to the continuing candidates.

iv) If the total number of the unexhausted paper is greater than the surplus, there shall be transferred from each sub-parcel the number of papers which bears the same

proportion to the number of papers in the sub-parcel as the surplus bears to the total number of un-exhausted papers, in the order in which such papers have been transferred.

(In other words, the number of paper to be transferred from each sub-parcel of transferable papers shall be ascertained by multiplying the numbers of paper in the sub-parcel by the surplus, and dividing the result by the total number of transferable papers. A note shall be made of the fractional part, if any, of each number so ascertained.)

(Votes in Sub-parcel x surplus)

Transferable Vote

f) If the surplus of any candidate to be transferred arises from transferred as well as original votes, all the papers in the sub-parcel last transferred to the candidates shall be re-examined and the unexhausted papers divided into sub-parcels according to the next preference recorded thereon. The sub-parcels shall be dealt within the same manner as is provided in the case sub-parcels referred to in clause (e).

g) The papers transferred to each candidate shall be added in the form of a sub - parcel to the papers already belonging to such candidate.

h) All papers in the parcel or sub- parcel of an elected candidate not transferred under this statute shall be set aside as finally dealt with.

7. a) If, after all the surpluses have been transferred as herein before directed, less than the number of candidates required has been elected the candidate lowest on the poll shall be excluded from the poll and his unexhausted papers distributed among the continuing candidates according to the next preference recorded thereon. Exhausted papers shall be set aside as finally dealt with.

b) The papers containing original votes of an excluded candidate shall first be transferred.

c) The papers containing transferred votes of an excluded candidate shall then be transferred in the order of the transfer in which he obtained them.

d) If, the total of the votes of two or more candidates, lowest on the poll, together with any surplus votes not transferred is less than the votes credited to the next highest candidate, those candidate may, in one operation be excluded from the poll and their votes transferred in accordance with the direction given in clauses (a) to (c) above.

e) The process shall be repeated on the successive exclusions of the candidates lowest on the poll until vacancy is filled either by the election of a candidate with the quota, or as here inafter provided.

8. If as a result of a transfer of papers under these Statutes, the number of votes obtained by a candidate is equal to or greater than the quota, the transfer then proceeding shall be completed but no further papers shall be transferred to him.

9. a) If after the completion of any transfer under these Statutes the number of the votes of any candidate is be equal to or greater than the quota, he shall be declared elected.

b) If the number of votes of any such candidate is be equal to the quota, the whole of the papers on which such votes are recorded shall be set aside as finally dealt with.

c) If the number of votes, of any such candidates is be greater than the quota, his surplus shall, thereupon be distributed in the manner therein before provided before the exclusion of any other candidate.

10. a) When the number of continuing candidates is reduced to the number of vacancies remaining unfilled the continuing candidate shall be deemed elected.

b) When only one vacancy remains unfilled and the number of votes of some one continuing candidate exceeds the total of all the votes of the other continuing candidates together with any surplus not transferred that candidate shall be deemed elected.

c) When only one vacancy remains unfilled and there are only two continuing candidates and those two candidates have each the same number of votes and no surplus remain capable of transfer, one candidate shall be excluded under clause (11) and the other deemed elected.

11. If when there is more than one surplus to be distributed, two or more surpluses are equal or if at any time it becomes necessary to exclude a candidate and two or more candidates have the same number of votes and are lowest on the poll, regard shall be had to the original

votes of each candidate and the candidates for whom fewest original votes are recorded shall have his surplus first distributed or shall be first excluded, as the case may be. If the number of their original votes is the same, the Returning Officer shall decide by lot which candidate shall have his surplus distributed or be excluded.

12. Any candidates or his agent, may at any time during the counting of the votes, either before the commencement or after the completion of any transfer of votes (Whether surplus or otherwise) request the Returning Officer to re-examine and re-count the papers of all candidates or any candidate (not being paper set aside at any previous transfer as finally dealt with) the Returning Officer shall forthwith re-examine and re-count the same with the help of such persons as he may appoint. The Returning Officer may also at his discretion re-count votes, either once or more often in any case in which he is not satisfied as to the accuracy of any previous count, provided that nothing there in shall obligatory on the Returning Officer to recount the same votes more than once.

13. The Returning Officer shall than declare the names of the candidates who have been duly elected.

St. 21. Candidates and a representative of each of the candidates appointed in writing by them and approved by the Returning Officer may be present at the time of scrutiny and counting of votes.

St. 22: Elections Returns:

The Returning Officer, shall prepare a statement showing:

1. The number of votes polled.
2. The number of ballot papers rejected as invalid.

St.23 : Coming into Operation and repeal:

The above Statutes shall come into force on date of assent by the Chancellor there to and all other Statutes relating to the Election shall stand repealed from the date of such assent.

- ii) a) Where there is a Department of Studies established and maintained by the University the Head of the Department of Studies concerned shall be the ex-officio member and Chairman of such Board of Studies.
- b) In all other cases the Chairman shall be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor from among the members.
- iii) Subject to the provision of clause (ii), (a) and (iv) and (v) all members of Boards of Studies shall be nominated by the Syndicate for a period of three years.
- iv) If there is a Department of Studies established and maintained by the University at least one of the members of each Board of Studies shall be nominated from the Department of Studies concerned.
- v) If there is provision for teaching of any subject of one of the subject grouped under a Board of Studies in any of the affiliated or constituent Colleges of the University at least one member of the Board of Studies shall be from among the teachers teaching the subject or any one of the subjects concerned.
- vi) A teacher of the Post-graduate Department of Studies of the University or a teacher of the affiliated/constituent colleges shall cease to be a member if he ceases to be a teacher of the concerned category to which he belonged to at the time of his nomination to the Board of Studies.
- vii) Any casual vacancy may be filled for the unexpired period.
- viii) The Vice-Chancellor shall nominate two additional members to each of the Board of Studies in the subject/ subjects from other Universities for a period of three years.
- ix) "Each Board of Studies by a resolution at a meeting co-opt two members working in the Karnatak University in the field as member(s) of the Board for a period which is co-terminal with the period of the Board."

Meetings:

- i) All Boards of Studies shall ordinarily meet at least once a year and on such occasions as may be determined by the Vice-Chancellor.

- ii) Not less than fifty percent of the members in each Board of Studies shall constitute the quorum for a meeting.
- iii) In the absence of the Chairman at any of the meetings of the Board of Studies one of the members elected by the members present shall act as Chairman for that meeting.
- iv) All questions before the Boards of Studies shall be decided by a majority of persons present and voting. In case of equality of votes on any issue, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.
- v) If in the opinion of the Vice-Chancellor, it is not necessary or expedient to convene a meeting of the Board of Studies to consider any item and if he considers that a matter could be disposed of by circulation among the members of the Board he may issue necessary instructions to that effect.

Joint Meetings:

- i) A joint meeting of two or more Boards of Studies may be convened if so directed by the Vice-Chancellor to consider matters as may be specified.
- ii) The Vice-Chancellor or a person designated by him shall preside over such meeting. The quorum for joint meeting shall not be less than 50% of the total number of members of all Boards so convened.
- iii) The joint meeting shall consider question/s or matter/s referred to it and shall submit a report thereon.

Functions of Boards of Studies:

- i) To consider and recommend courses of Studies, text books standards of passing and conduct of examinations, preparation of panels of examiners and any other academic matter concerned or related to matters specified above.
- ii) To consider and report on all other matters as may be referred to it by any authority/officer of the University.

 - A) Principal (as a cadre in the faculty of Engineering)
 - B) Professors
 - C) Readers/Asst. Professor/Associate Professor
 - D) Lecturers
2. A Professor or a Reader shall be designated the Principal in a college except in respect of colleges coming under the faculties of Medicine and Indian System of Medicine, where Professor shall be designated as a Principal.
3. The minimum educational qualifications and experience, for being designated as Principal or for being appointed to a teaching posts shall be as provided for in the Annexure.
4. Relaxation of qualifications mentioned in the annexure may be granted by the Syndicate, in special circumstances to employees who are already in Service.

Statutes regarding classification and qualifications of Teachers in affiliated and constituent colleges of Karnatak University.

A) Arts/Social Science/Sciences/ Commerce/Physical Education:**1. Principal:**

- i) Second class Master's Degree.
- ii) Second class at the First degree examination.
- iii) At least 7 years of teaching experience as the college/colleges.
- iv) The appointment of Principal of a college is subject to the approval of the University.
- v) Qualifications specified above may be relaxed at the discretion of the Syndicate provided the candidate has Ph.D. or he has to his credit research work of equivalent standard.

2. Professors:

- i) Second Class Master's degree and Second Class Bachelor's degree or second class Honours degree with research degree in the concerned subject.
- ii) 10 years professional experience or experience of teaching degree or post-graduate classes or capacity to carry out independent research work and to guide students for research degree.

- i) Second Class Master's degree and Second class Bachelor's degree (Second Class means 50% or more)
- ii) Preference shall generally be given for first class at P.G and/or Ph.D. in the concerned subject.

1. Professors:

Qualifications same as Lecturer with 5 years teaching experience.

Revised Recommendation of the Medical Council of India the qualifications required for appointment of persons to the posts of Teachers and Visiting Physicians, Surgeons etc. in Medical colleges and attached hospitals for undergraduate and post-graduate teaching, as approved by

the Council as its meeting held on 16-3-1974 after complying with the procedure as laid-down u/s 19-A of the I.M.C. Act. 1956.

General:

1. All the medical teachers must possess a bais University of equivalent qualifications included in the Schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act. 1956. They should also be registered under the State/ Central Medical Registration Act.
2. In the departments of Anatomy, Physiology Pharmacology, Biochemistry, and Microbiology non-medical teachers may be appointed to the x-extent of 30% of the total number of posts in the department. Non-medical teachers in the above subjects should passess and approved post-graduate qualifications in the subject and preferably held a doctorate in the subject. The Head of these departments must possess a recognised basic University medical degree qualification or equivalent qualification.

However a non-medical teacher in Bio-chemistry in a Medical College with doctorate qualification in Biochemistry may also be considered for the post of the Head of the Dept. of Biochemistry.

3. Medical teachers in medical colleges except the tutors, residents registrars, and demonstrators must possess the requisite recognised post-graduate qualification in their respective subjects.
4. 50% of the time spent in research schemes under the Indian council of Medical Research for Council of Scientific and Industrial Research or equivalent bodies after obtaining the requisite recognised post-graduate qualification be counted towards teaching experience in the same subject provided that 50% of the teaching experience shall be the regular teaching experience.
5. Holder of equivalent post-graduate qualifications which may be approved by the medical Council of India from time to time, may be considered to have the requisite recognised post-graduate qualification in the subject concered.
6. 'Equivalent qualification' referred to in the recommendations shall be determined by the Council alone.
7. Teachers in a Medical College having atleast 7 years under-graduate teaching experience of which not less than 4 years should be after

obtaining the requisite recognised post-graduate qualification, shall be recognised as post-graduate teachers.

8. Other teaching staff in the Uni. may also participate in post-graduate teaching.
9. Published Research work should be given due weightage in making appointments to teaching posts.
10. In all cases the qualifications and experience should be as scheduled above. However in case where candidates with regarding experience are not available, a reference may be made to the Council for consideration on merits.

NB : Where the departments have been bifurcated, the teaching experience acquired in the original departments will count towards appointments in either of the bifurcated departments.

Note: These recommendations will take effect from 1st July 1975 or one year after the approval by the Government of India as regulations under section 88 (k) of the India Medical Council Act 1956, whichever is later.

Teachers holding posts of the rank of associate professor/readers and above prior to the above date possessing qualifications and experience as prescribed under the regulations of the council as approved by the Government of India vide their letter No. F. 4 126/5 MPT dated 5th June 1971 can continue in their posts and also be eligible for promotion to higher posts.

But teachers holding posts lower than the rank of associate professor/reader possessing qualifications as prescribed under their regulations of council as approved by the Government of India vide their letter No. F4-12-65 MPI, dated 5th June 1971 but not according to the present regulations can continue in their posts but will not be eligible for promotion to higher posts unless they satisfy the present requirements.

Provided further that candidate appointed as teachers prior to 5th June 1971 and not satisfying either the above requirements can continue in the posts they were occupying as on 5th June 1971.
