*Sub:* Statutes and ordinances regarding affiliation of P.G. Course in the existing affiliated Engineering Colleges in addition to Under-graduate Course.

It is hereby notified to all the Engineering Colleges under jurisdiction of Karnatak University, Dharwad that the Statute and Ordinances regarding grant of affiliation for teaching P.G. courses in the affiliated Engineering Colleges in addition to the Undergraduate courses framed under section 35(9) and 25(9) (iv) of the K.S.U. Act 1976 are enclosed herewith for information.

Statutes under Section 35(9) of the K.S.U. Act 1976 regarding establishment of a new P.G. Course in the existing Engineering Colleges in addition to the instruction in Undergraduate Courses.

#### Fresh Affiliation

1. An existing affiliated Engg. College Management seeking affiliation of a fresh P.G. course, in addition to the existing undergraduate courses, shall make an application (in ten sets) in the prescribed forms to the Registrar, Karnatak University, Dharwad-3 along with

necessary amount of fees for fresh P.G. affiliation as per ordinance framed in this behalf, so as to reach him within the due date mentioned in the notification calling the applications for affiliation.

**Continuation of Affiliation :**

2. Where a college is affiliated temporarily for a specific period providing P.G. instruction, the college shall apply of continuation of affiliation before 30th September of the proceeding year of its expiry of affiliation, with the prescribed fees as per ordinances fixed from time to time. In continuation of affiliation, it is the Continuation of affiliation of the same subjects/courses as already granted affiliation.

**Extension of Affiliation:**

3. In extension of affiliation, the college may apply for affiliation of new subjects or new courses alongwith the subjects/courses already affiliated, in the prescribed application forms (in 10 sets) alongwith the necessary fees as per ordinances fixed from time to time.

**Eligibility:**

4. The existing Engineering colleges which have fulfilled the affiliation conditions of University shall alone be held eligible to apply for fresh affiliation for starting of P.G. courses.
5. In addition to the undergraduate courses, the existing Engineering colleges may apply for affiliation of a Master course in Engineering Faculty as there is no dept. of studies in Engineering in the University.
6. The prescribed applications can be had from the University Office on payment of Rs.50/- in person and Rs.60/- by post. The amount shall be in the form of D.D. payable to the Finance Officer, K.U. Dharwad payable at the State Bank of India, K. U. Campus Branch, Dharwad-3.
7. Provision has been made to establish the Master degree courses in Engineering in the following subjects:
  1. Civil Engineering: Structural Engineering.
  2. Mechanical Engg. : Production Management.
  3. Energy Systems Engineering.
8. The fees for affiliation of new courses shall be governed by the Ordinances in force from time to time.
9. The staff duly qualified as per All India Council of Technical Education shall be appointed for teaching work for the P.G. courses.

10. For each course, the students intake shall be ten and the number may be increased after due facilities are provided and on the recommendation of the L.I.C.
11. Lecturer rooms, Laboratory facilities, equipment, books separate library facilities, staff rooms, furnitures etc., shall be provided as recommended by the LIC from time to time and approved by the Academic Council and Syndicate.
12. College shall fulfil conditions as specified in Section 53 of the KSU Act., 1976 and other conditions as may be recommended by the LIC and approved by the Academic Council and Syndicate.
13. All The P.G. Students shall be provided with hostel accommodation on their request.
14. All facilities provided for the Undergraduate students shall be extended to the P.G. Students also.
15. To establish cordial relationship between the P.G. and Undergraduate students. For this, a small committee shall be constituted with the Principal of the college as Chairman, the Dean, Students Welfare of the college as a Secretary and six students representatives of which two from P.G. level and four from the Undergraduate level.
16. The colleges shall abide by the Statutes Ordinances and other rules of the University framed from time to time.
17. The recognised invitee teachers for P.G. teaching shall be paid remuneration as may be fixed by the Ordinances from time to time.

**Ordinances relating to the Constitution powers and functions of Planning and Monitoring Board.**

**Constitution:**

0.1. The Planning and Monitoring Board shall consist of

- 1) The Vice-Chancellor(Chairman)
- 2) Four out side experts to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.
- 3) Deans of Faculties.



- 4) Three nominees of the Vice-Chancellor from the University's own staff for their special interest in Educational progress and development.
- 5) Finance Officer
- 6) Registrar (Secretary)

The tenure of the members may be for a period of three years. The Board should meet at least twice a year and the recommendation of the Board shall be placed before the Academic Council and the Syndicate.

#### Powers and Functions:

1. To examine the question and suggestion measures to raising the Standard of Education and research to strengthen inter- disciplinary Programmes and inter-departmental co-operation to create links and develop sepcific schemes of Inter- University and University/ Industry/Agriculture/Community inter-action. To develop ideals and schemes in improving corporate life and cultural activities on the campus.
2. To prepare University plans both short term and long term keeping in view of the objectives of the University as laid down in the Act and with due regard to national policy.
3. To monitor regularly implementation of schemes approved by the UGC and other agencies and suggest methods for proper implementations.
4. Academic Council/Syndicate may obtain advice of the Board on any issue.
5. Board shall have the power to appoint such sub-committee as it deems fit for carrying out the objectives of the Board.

St. 1) A college may apply for permanent affiliation if it has worked satisfactorily for at least 5 years and subject to the following conditions.

- i) The college should have fulfilled the deposit condition stipulated at the time of affiliation.
- ii) The college should have its own building or some permanent accommodation with adequate space for all its needs.
- iii) The college should provide adequate playground, sports facilities and sanitary facilities for staff and students.
- iv) College should have adequate library and reading room facilities.
- v) Staff should be adequate and duly qualified and employed on regular and permanent basis and should not be subjected to arbitrary conditions of service.
- vi) The financial position of the institution should be sound so as to continue to maintain the good standard for permanent affiliation. The college should have fulfilled the requirements of library, laboratory and other facilities as per the general guidelines for affiliation of fresh, continuation and extension of courses.
- vii) College should have been included in the 2(f) of the U.G.C. Act.
- viii) College should have Principals quarters.

**For unaided colleges additional requirements are:**

- ix) Compulsory "Contributory provided Fund" Scheme for their employees.
- x) Other staff welfare measures.
- xi) A nominee of the University on the selection Committees of the teaching Staff.

St. 2) There shall be triennial inspection for colleges that have been granted permanent affiliation to see that these are maintaining good academic standards. This committee shall ordinarily consist of experienced persons specialised in the areas in which the college is imparting education.

St. 3) The University shall prescribe the fees for permanent affiliation and call for any information before inspection of a college.

**NOTE:** The University will notify the proforma of application' date and time of receipt of application. The application may be called every year.

**POWERS, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE DEPARTMENTAL COUNCIL AND OF CHAIRMAN**

**A. Departmental Council:**

1. The Council shall meet as under:
  - a) On the first and the last working day of each term. In addition to this there shall atleast be one meeting during each term (b) once during 1st week of every month of each term and (c) on any other occasion if convened by the Chairman or on requisition by 25% of the members of the Departmental Council.
2. The Chairman, shall convene and preside over such meetings.
3. In the absence of the Chairman of the Department, the Incharge shall preside over the meeting.



4. All members of the council are normally required to attend the meeting of the Council. The quorum shall be 2/3 of the members of the Departmental Council. Meeting notice will be issued 3 days in advance.
5. The agenda for the meeting shall be prepared by the Chairman and circulated to all the members at least one day prior to the meeting. Any proposal sent by member, regarding the activities of the Department shall be included in the agenda.
6. Minutes of every meeting shall be recorded in minutes register to be maintained by the Chairman wherein the signature of the all members attending the meeting shall be recorded at the foot of the minutes of such meeting. The register shall be made available to every member for inspection at his request.
7. All decisions shall be by majority of members present at the meeting. In case of equality of votes Chairman will have casting vote.

**B. The Departmental Council shall have the following powers & functions. It shall.**

1. Prepare the budget of the department and make recommendations for re-appropriation:
2. Distribute the budgeted funds of the department among various sections and research groups.
3. Prepare the list of equipments, chemicals, spares, furnitures, etc., required for the department.
4. Prepare proposals for and implement, supervise the special project and schemes such as Cosip, Cosip Leadership D.S.A. D.R.S., etc., but not including proposals submitted to various funding agencies by individuals or groups of individuals.
5. Organise the teaching programme throughout the year.
6. Decide upon invitation and organisation of special lectures seminars, symposium, workshops, etc.
7. Prepare draft proposals for introduction revision, alteration of courses of study or syllabi.
8. Decide upon the curricular and extra curricular activities concerning the department.
9. Make recommendations regarding admission of candidates to M.Phil. and Ph.D.

10. Recommend the number of students capacity to be admitted to various courses of study excluding Ph.D.
11. Make recommendations for purchase of books & journals.
12. Prepare draft Annual Report of the Department.
13. Constitute committees to discharge any of the powers and
14. To consider any other matter that may be brought before it by the Chairman or members of the Council concerning the department.

**C. Powers, Functions and Duties of the Chairman of the Departmental Council.**

The Chairman of the Departmental Council shall:

1. be responsible for the administration of the department;
2. implement all decisions taken by the departmental council;
3. have power to recommend disciplinary action against students;
4. be responsible for maintenance of accounts, office records, libraries, vehicles etc., of the department;
5. arrange for the admission of students to courses of studies of the departments excluding Ph.D. and M.Phil.
6. such other powers, duties and functions as prescribed or assigned.

The amendment to the Statute 169 Governing the conditions of acceptance of donations and endowments for establishment of fellowships, Scholarships, Prizes, Medals etc., is assented to by H.E. the Chancellor on 3-2-89. The assent of the Chancellor is communicated through the State Govt. Under letter No. referred to at Sl. No.4. The Statute 169 reads as under:



*Statute '169'*

"All offers of bequests, donations and endowments, the management where of is to be vested in the University may be accepted on conditions that the Annual income there from shall be subject to a deduction of 10% thereof, out of which 5% will be added to corpus and the remaining amount so realised by such annual deduction shall be credited to the General fund of the University at the commencement of every financial year.

1. The University shall not accept an endowment for the establishment of fellowships, Scholarships, Prizes, Gold Medals, and other merit awards which are not open to all students of this University in the concerned course/ paper at an examination, irrespective of caste, creed, community, religion and region.
2. The University shall not accept endowments whose corpus is less than Rs.25,000/- in the case of Scholarships and Rs.15,000/- in the case of prizes and Gold Medals and Rs.35,000/- in the case of endowments lectures and Rs 15 lakhs for Institution of a "Chair".
3. No donation for an award of Gold Medal or Prize shall be accepted in respect of course/ paper at an examination to which the award relates, if there are already two or more gold medals or prizes as the case may be instituted in respect of same course or paper. However, the University may advise intending/donors for instituting Gold Medals or Prizes in the areas where such gold Medals prizes/Scholarships are not Instituted.
4. No endowments will be instituted without being accepted by the Syndicate.
5. Where the amount of interest accruing on the Corpus is not sufficient to obtain a Gold Medal manufactured, the University shall have discretion to award of prize in lieu of Gold Medal. However, before awarding such cash prize, the University shall request the Donor or the awardee wherever possible as to whether he/she is willing to donate additional amount to enable the University to supplement the corpus for which Gold Medal is instituted.

6. No Gold Medal shall be accepted for Ph.D. unless it is instituted for a particular specialisation".

For the Service rendered between the age of 55 or 58 and 60, the University will pay the pension and DCRG based on the pay drawn in the University service at the age of 60, less pension and gratuity payable by the Government according to the Government Order stated above.

b) 1. Where there is a Department of Studies established and maintained by the University, the Chairman of the Board of Studies shall be senior-most Professor in the Department. If there is no Professor in the Department the Senior-most Reader shall be the Chairman. In those Departments where there is neither Professor nor Reader the Dean of the concerned Faculty shall be the Chairman.

2. In all other cases the Chairman shall be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor from among the members.

3. The Vice-Chancellor shall nominate two additional members to each of the Board of Studies in the Subject/Subjects from other Universities for a period of three years.

4. Each Board of Studies by a resolution at a meeting co-opt two members working in the Karnatak University/College in the field as member(s) of the Board for a period which is co-terminal with the period of the Board.

5. The Syndicate shall nominate required number of members on each Board.

6. While nominating members to the Under-Graduate Board of Studies teachers of the under-graduate courses shall be given adequate representation.

## THE STATUTE

Statute governing the rules of business of Boards of Studies (Section-35(j) of the K.S.U. Act).

### Meetings :

- All Boards of Studies shall ordinarily meet at least once in a year and on such occasions as may be determined by the Vice-Chancellor.
- Not less than fifty percent of the members in each Board of Studies shall constitute the Quorum for a meeting.
- In the absence of the Chairman at any of the meetings of the Board of Studies one of the members elected by the members present shall act as Chairman for that meeting.
- All questions before the Boards of Studies shall be decided by a majority of persons present and voting. In case of equality of votes on any issue, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.
- If in the opinion of the Vice-Chancellor, it is not necessary or expedient to convene a meeting of the Board of Studies to consider any items, and if he considers that a matter could be disposed of by circulation among the members of the Board he may issue necessary instructions to that effect.

### Joint Meetings :

- A joint meeting of two or more Boards of Studies may be convened if so directed by the Vice-Chancellor to consider matter/s as may be specified.
- The Vice-Chancellor or a person designated by him shall preside over such meeting. The quorum for joint meeting shall not be less than 50% of the total number of members of all Boards so convened.
- The joint meeting shall consider question(s) or matter/s referred to it and shall submit a report thereon.

### Functions of Boards of Studies :

- To consider & recommend Courses of Studies, Text Books, Standards of passing and conduct of examinations, preparation of panels of examiners and any other academic matter concerned or related matters specified above.
- To consider and report on all other matters as may be referred to it by any authority/Officer of the University.

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
